Toy Tape

Made to Play: An activity that encourages preschoolers to follow guidelines while having fun and learning new concepts

What You Need: Toys and painter's tape/masking tape

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Gather simple small toys from around your house. Place the toys on a table or hard floor. Use the tape to tape each toy to the table or floor.

During the Activity: Challenge the children to peel the tape and free the toys. Continue the activity until each toy has been freed.

After the Activity: Allow the children to play with the freed toys.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Oh, no! Our toys are taped to the table (floor)." (*Point.*)

During the Activity: "Please, help me free our toys by peeling the tape. (*Demonstrate.*) It will be a hard job, but then we will be able to play with our toys!" (*Do activity.*)

After the Activity: "Whew! That was a super hard job. You did so good, and now we can play with our toys again! Today, we'll hear a Bible story about how we can follow God's plan, even when it is hard!"
