This Month's Memory Verse:

“For I know the plans I have for you,’ says the LORD.” Jeremiah 29:11, NLT

Bubble Verse

Made to Move: An activity that uses a preschooler's natural desire to move to help them learn

What You Need: Bubble Solution

What You Do:

Before the Activity:

Have the children stand in front of you.

During the Activity:

Blow the bubbles toward the children. Encourage the children to pop all of the bubbles and say the memory verse.

“For I know (*point to head*)

the plans I have for you,’ (*march*)

says (*hands to mouth like yelling*)

the LORD, (*point up*)

Jeremiah 29:11 (NLT).” (*Open your hands like a book.*)

Repeat several times.

Note: For kindergartners and/or prereaders, be prepared to help them write short words in each blank. Don't worry about correcting their spelling. Let them sound it out and write as best they can. If they are really struggling, write in “Smile” for the mouth; “Listen” for the ears; “Help” for the hands; and “Hug” for the arms.

What You Say:

Before the Activity:

“I am so excited to play with bubbles!”

During the Activity:

“When I blow the bubbles, you may pop them. When you pop the bubbles, let's say our memory verse together with motions. Are you ready? (*Pause and do activity.*) Great job!”

After the Activity:

“Great job! Bubbles are so much fun! Our memory verse tells us that God has a plan for us! **Who has a plan for you? God has a plan for me!**”
