

God worked in incredible ways through you and our entire church family in 2021, and we're eager for all the bold ways He'll continue to move in the coming year. As we head into another year still significantly impacted by Covid-19, we want to acknowledge the negative impact and toll the pandemic has taken on many of you. Wherever you find yourself today, please know that you have both our warmest prayers and sincerest gratitude.

Because of your selfless giving of time, talent, and treasures, we were able to continue to saturate greater Austin — and beyond — with the love of Jesus. There is so much to celebrate this year, and below we highlight just a few of the ways our church shared the good news with others.

- **3,200 people engaged with the Family Assessment,** making plans to increase their intentionality in their most important relationships.
- We gave \$150,000 toward Bible translation in East and Central Asia, providing 3.2 million unreached people first-time access to the gospel.
- We provided \$50,000 to help broadcast *The Jesus Film* in six closed access cities, and 2,500 people have made decisions for Christ to-date.
- Adults of all ages are finding authentic and life-changing community in 166 small groups across the city.
- 133 adults and students were baptized during 2021, and 223 children accepted Christ during the Great Adventure Week.
- During our Fall Food Drive, we collected 15,000 pounds of food, helping to put Thanksgiving meals on 500 tables.
- We commissioned three families to the nations as long-term missionaries to Southeast Asia, West Africa, and Europe, bringing our total supported missionaries around the world to 66.
- We collected \$140,000 during our Christmas Special Offering, benefiting local Pregnancy Resource Centers.
