## **MY APPLICATION**

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1. Read John 13:34-35. What was "new" about the new commandment Jesus gave to his disciples since the command to love was already in existence? (Leviticus 19:18; Mark 12:28-31) How is this seen in the example of washing the disciples' feet? (John 13:12-17)
- 2. Have you ever been in a "community of believers" that had a spiritually transforming impact on your life?

  Describe what it was like.
- 3. Peter pushed back against a community of believers and wanted Jesus to stay with them. What did Jesus say he would be doing in his absence? (John 13:36-14:4) Is Jesus really the only way to God? (John 14:5-6) Why?
- 4. Jesus calls us to do for others what he did for us, to introduce us to God the Father. (John 14:12) Do you feel that you are actively showing Jesus to people in your life? What are some of the greater works Jesus told his followers to expect? Are you seeing the works of God coming from your life?
