Stocking Surprise

What You Need:

Christmas stocking, small Christmas-related items (some suggestions are a jingle bell, Christmas bow for wrapping, candy cane, jewelry gift box, ornament, toy animal etc.), ribbon to close the stocking, timer, paper, and pencils

What You Do:

- Form two teams.
- Give a piece of paper and a pencil to each team.
- Hold up the stocking to show that it is filled with Christmas-y things.
- The object of the game is to feel the stocking and to try to guess as many items as they can before the timer goes off.
- Set the timer for 30 seconds and give the stocking to the first team.
- Team 1 has 30 seconds to feel the stocking (no opening it!) and write down what they think is in it.
- When the timer goes off, the next team gets a chance to guess.
- Now Team 2 has 30 seconds to feel the stocking and guess what is inside.
- After both teams have gone, they can share their guesses.
- Then, open the stocking and show everyone what items are inside.
