ACTIVITY

Baa Baa Bowls

What You Need:

Spoons, cotton balls, bowls, and timer

What You Do:

- Mark a starting line and tell everyone to line-up side by side.
- Give each person a spoon.
- Make a pile of cotton balls on the floor in front of each person.
- Set up the bowls at the opposite end of the room.
- When you say “go,” they will scoop up a cotton ball on their spoon, run it down to their bowl, and then run back.
- If they drop the cotton ball, they must pick it up using the spoon and then continue to their bowl. Only use the spoon to touch the cotton ball, even if they drop it.
- The person with the most cotton balls in their bowl after a minute wins!
- Play several rounds. The person that wins the most rounds is the winner!
