OUR APPROACH TO MINISTRY

The pandemic created an opportunity for us to minister to our church family and beyond in different ways. We revitalized our approach to ministry, helping us to continue to spread Jesus' love. This year, we were pleased to welcome Senior Executive Director Justin Rasberry, Teaching Pastor and Leander Location Director Jim Botts, new staff focused on engaging our children, and other key roles to help our church accomplish God's mission.

The pandemic also prompted our leadership to refocus our one church in multiple locations model, creating greater unity and living out Ephesians 4. Following God's calling in Ephesians, we are committed to:






