Conversations at Home

Parents, our desire is to partner with you in the discipleship of your student. This week we will be opening God's Word together and reading about a really awkward guy in Matthew 3. In this chapter, we meet John the Baptist—a guy who dressed, ate, and said things that were not normal in his time. People would say he was an awkward guy. But why did he do these things? He was called to live differently or as the Bible called it, he was called to live a holy life. To others, this does seem like an awkward way to live but holiness is key in our Christian life.

Here are some questions you can use to follow up with your student(s):

1. Have you ever felt the pressure to not do what you thought was right because you thought it would be seen as weird or awkward? What was it?
2. Why do you think it is so hard to live a holy life?
3. What is one thing you are going to change in your thinking or actions that will help you live a holy life?
