CAMPUS TECHNICAL COORDINATOR

Job Classification: Non-Exempt | Full Time February 2019

OUTCOMES AND RESULTS – SUCCESS IN THIS POSITION WILL RESULT IN:

- 1. A high anticipation of God's presence at all worship services and special events because they are supported with technical excellence.
- 2. The mission of Hill Country Bible Church is advanced: Each of us, together... saturating Greater Austin with the love of Jesus.
- 3. Church-wide and special events (Christmas, Easter, Concert of Prayer, Concert of Praise, large conferences, and other major church-wide events) are supported with excellent technical and production support.
- 4. Focused technical expertise and support to one of our Hill Country Campuses as assigned.
- 5. Healthy volunteer teams are engaged in meaningful ministry and are continually being recruited, trained, and empowered; leaders are developed and given greater ownership of the ministry.
- 6. Hill Country technical equipment (AVL) is administered and maintained at a high level.
- 7. Hill Country ministries and Hill Country Christian School (HCCSA) receive timely and excellent technical support, resourcing, and training to move the vision forward.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACTIVITIES (30HRS):

- 1. Develop and execute a clear yearly calendar for all training/equipping of tech volunteers for assigned Hill Country campuses in collaboration with the Production Director.
- 2. Assist with installs and the preventative maintenance of AVL equipment at all Hill Country Campuses.
- 3. Setup and operate tech equipment as assigned by the Production Director for various events/ministries throughout the week (including but not limited to Worship rehearsals, Bible Studies, Celebrate Recovery, HCCSA events, Weddings, Funerals, Staff Meetings, etc.).
- 4. Cross train on all IMAG equipment for any Sunday programming/production needs and events outside of Sunday mornings. Program lights, sequence and setup ProPresenter, and run sound as needed.
- 5. Quickly identify problems and make "on the spot" appropriate fixes (short term solutions); evaluate, diagnose and make proper repairs/replacement for equipment on an ongoing basis (long term solutions) in collaboration with the Production Director.
- 6. Engage in weekly Production Team meetings, church staff meetings, and 1:1 meetings with Production Director. Adopt campus-wide practices for consistency in all AVL, service flow, and service style.
- 7. Serve as an active member of the overall church and staff team; commit to personal evangelism; participate in church-wide initiatives.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACTIVITIES FOR DESIGNATED HILL COUNTRY CAMPUS (10HRS):

- 1. Oversee the technical execution, set-up/tear down, FOH mix, and video stream of the specific, assigned Hill Country Campus.
- 2. Coordinate and schedule volunteers for Sunday services and other events using PCO (Planning Center Online tool).
- 3. Provide high level support for AVL (as well as troubleshoot in the moment) for all rehearsals, setup/teardown, Sunday services and special events (ministry specific/or outreach) sponsored by the campus
- 4. Recruit, train, encourage and empower volunteer teams to serve the technical, video and sound needs; build relational capital with the campus family/community; develop leaders
- 5. Work with the Campus Staff to meaningfully integrate technology into all aspects of the service as well as to support the band/vocal/message and environment needs
- 6. Follow AVL preventative maintenance schedule on all systems and gear related to the campus
- 7. Consult with the Production Director for any updates/replacements/installs needed for the campus

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- 1. 3+ years of tech/production experience (in a similar context)
- 2. Strong AVL technical and production skills. Live sound mixing on digital consoles, lighting design and programming, projection setup, and video production (live capture and streaming).
- 3. Knowledge of signal flow and troubleshooting.
- 4. Ability to lead and train volunteers from a position of "servant leadership".
- 5. Strong work ethic ability to complete weekly tasks in timely manner with a servant heart.
- 6. Flexible must be able to do what it takes to make things happen.
- 7. Multitasking must be able and thrive moving from one task to another in an efficient manner.
- 8. Teachable.
- 9. Team player. Ability to work within a strong collaborative environment.
- 10. Must be able to lift various types of AVL equipment and staging, climb ladders, and operate lifts working at various heights.
- 11. Ability to work with Mac OS, ProPresenter, Planning Center Online, Jands Vista Byron, and Living as One. Advanced training provided.
- 12. Availability to work Sunday worship services, Christmas Eve and Easter, and some evenings as needed.
- 13. Alignment with our Core Beliefs (see website) and commitment to become an active member of Hill Country Bible Church within 8 weeks of hire
