- 10. Cross train on skills with Maintenance Manager and other Maintenance Technician(s)
- 11. Assist in recruiting, planning, executing and leading volunteers for monthly Work Saturdays
- 12. Maintain a clean and orderly work area
- 13. Conduct building inspections as needed and open Work Orders for needed repairs

## REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- 3. General knowledge of Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing (MEP) troubleshooting and repair
