OUTCOMES AND RESULTS - SUCCESS IN THIS POSITION WILL RESULT IN:

- 1. Hill Country Small Groups ignite and fuel authentic community that connects, grows, and BLESSes (Acts 2:46-47).
 - a. CONNECT with each other in close, Biblical relationships
 - b. GROW in our relationship with God, and
 - c. BLESS those who don't yet know Jesus Christ
- 2. The Small Groups Ministry moves the vision and mission of Hill Country Bible Church forward; ministry activities and priorities align and advance the Small Groups Ministry Purpose and Plan (MP& P)
- 3. People are experiencing life change in Small Groups community:
 - a. People are coming to faith in Jesus Christ because individuals in our small groups are living out and sharing the Gospel
 - b. Small Group participants are engaged in meaningful community and growing as disciples of Jesus Christ, living out His call to make disciples who make disciples (Fully Formed Followers)
 - c. Small Group leaders and coaches (new and existing) are identified, developed, and deployed; a thriving small group Ministry Leadership Team is shepherded well and taking greater ownership of the ministry across all locations (Leadership Development through an Eph 4 model)

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Understand and demonstrate ownership of the mission and vision of Hill Country through an aligned Ministry Purpose and Plan (MP&P)
- 2. Equip and develop small group leaders and coaches to strengthen the mission of HCBC and to make disciples who make disciples (Fully Formed Followers of Jesus Christ)
- 3. Model our relational philosophy of ministry who are you, where are you at spiritually, and how can I help you take the next step
- 4. Train, equip, resource, and ensure that small group leaders and coaches have practical ways to connect with and reach their un-churched community with the Gospel (an intentional approach to Gospel Saturation through a BLESS approach see GS and DM below)
- 5. Develop leaders for the ministry as well as for an over-arching leadership pipeline of future pastors, church planters, elders, missionaries, and more
- 6. Lead the Small Group Ministry though a servant leader Ministry Leadership Team
- 7. Serve as a contributing member of the overall HCBC Austin staff team at the Director level
- 8. Collaborate with pastors, directors, and leaders at the Lakeline Location to help ministries integrate a lifetransforming small group philosophy in their ministry.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACTIVITIES for Gospel Saturation & Disciple Making:

- 1. Works with the Discipleship Pastor in the implementation of the Gospel Saturation (GS) & Disciple Making (DM) Ministry Purpose and Plan
- 2. Sits on the GS/DM Core Leadership team and commits to lead one of the HCBC locations in the areas of GS & DM
- 3. Equips small group leaders and ministry leaders in BLESS and Gospel Saturation through groups
- 4. Equips disciple makers in different aspects of Fully Formed Follower of Jesus Christ

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- 1. Passion for Small Groups ministry with evidence of life change/transformation in small group community
- 2. Proven ability to communicate well in a variety of settings small groups, large groups, training, etc.
- 3. Learner and leader; proven abilities and interpersonal skills in personal evangelism, disciple making, and developing leaders by employing practical and relevant methods
- 4. Understands and models the HCBC approach to making disciples and evangelizing those far from God
- 5. Sees themselves as an owner of the mission, vision, values, and pathway of Hill Country Bible Church
- 6. Theologically aligns with the core beliefs of HCBC and becomes a church member within 3 months of hire
- 7. BA or BS preferred

CULTURE AND CLIMATE:

- 1. Position reports to the Small Groups Lead Pastor
- 2. Staff culture is goal-oriented, collaborative, with accountability, priority of personal evangelism
