Church Planter Pathway Stage Definitions

Finding: Identifying leaders within Hill Country Bible Church who evidence an above average level of spiritual leadership are invited into a next step developmental environment.

Forming: Those who continue to make progress in spiritual leadership are invited to take a step of more formal discipleship and spiritual growth. These men are envisioned to prayerfully consider the possibility that God may be calling them to plant a church.

Finishing: Leaders who have proven to be effective disciple makers, capable in leading people spiritually, and have been assessed to have a call of God to start a church are coached in the steps necessary to launch a new church planting church.

Fortifying: Post-church launch, these leaders continue to be coached and poured into to help maximize the effectiveness, fruitfulness, and spiritual vitality of the planter and the church.
